

REGION 15 Scholarship Application

The 2010 Scholarship Application year starts January 1, 2010, and ends May 30, 2010.

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic ability, leadership and involvement in equine activities. The Award is to be used toward undergraduate educational expenses at an institution of higher learning that is one which may only be attended upon receipt of a high school diploma or its equivalent. This includes college, universities, junior or community colleges offering an associate degree, and trade schools providing education in a field leading to permanent employment.

Two (2) scholarships of \$1,000.00 each will be award. Given adequate numbers of qualified applications in each category, one will be awarded to a graduating high school senior and one to a current college student. All may re-apply, but in no case will the same applicant receive two consecutive awards or more than two total awards.

An applicant must be a current member of AHA and **a Region 15 Club**; must reside in Region 15 and must have graduated or will be graduating high school when applying.

Requirements:

1. One (1) page letter stating your reasons for wanting a scholarship and Your personal goals for furthering your education.
2. Three (3) letters of recommendation as follows:
 - a. One (1) from horseman/horsewoman who is an adult member of their Region 15 club.
 - b. One (1) from an academic teacher or advisor.
 - c. One (1) from an employer, clergy, volunteer coordinator, etc.
3. High School transcript, fall semester of current year/most up to date transcript available at time of applying.
4. Head and shoulder photograph, approximately 3 x 5 inches.
5. Activities summary: list no more than ten (10) activities, school and equine events (both breed and open) that have contributed to your personal growth. **Please** confine to two pages or less.
6. **Copy of current AHA Membership card.**
